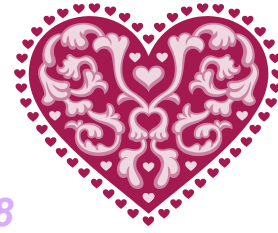




ASP Update – February 2008
